

NORTHERN VIRGINIA DISTRICT PTA 2017-2018 District Nominating Committee Election

Northern Virginia District PTA Bylaws require the election of a Nominating Committee at the Annual Meeting prior to the election year. Nominations will be accepted from the floor at the 2017 District Annual Meeting in accordance with bylaws. Nominees will need to give their consent and be nominated.

NOTE: Revised 2017 NOVA District Bylaws will be voted on prior to the election of Nominating Committee members.

2012 District PTA Bylaws: Article X: OFFICERS AND THEIR ELECTION

Section 5. *A nominating committee shall be elected at the annual meeting prior to the election year.*

- a. Each member of the committee must be a current member of a local PTA/PTSA unit in good standing within the district.*
- b. The committee shall consist of five (5) members, and shall include at least one local PTA/PTSA member from each of the cities and/or counties in the district whenever possible.*
- c. Immediately after its election, the committee shall meet (1) to elect a chairman and (2) to be instructed in its duties by the Virginia PTA/PTSA State Representative.*
- d. The committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees to the members of the executive board and to the presidents of each member association at least thirty (30) days before the annual meeting. At the annual meeting, additional nominations may be made from the floor.*
- e. Only those persons who have signified their consent to serve if elected shall be nominated for or elected to such office.*

PROVISO: If 2017 Proposed Bylaws are adopted, then the following new language will be effective and only three members will be elected to serve on the 2017-18 Nominating Committee.

2017 DISTRICT BYLAWS, ARTICLE 6: OFFICERS AND THEIR ELECTION

#Section 3. Nominating committee

a. Each member of the nominating committee must be a member of a local PTA/PTSA unit in good standing within the district.

b. The nominating committee shall consist of three (3) members who shall be elected by this district voting body at the general membership annual meeting prior to the election year. No two members of the nominating committee shall be from the same city and/or county within the district, whenever possible. Immediately after its election, the nominating committee shall meet to elect a chairman and to be instructed in its duties by the Virginia PTA representative.

c. The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees to the members of the executive board and to the presidents of each local PTA/PTSA at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting. At the annual meeting, additional nominations may be made from the floor.

d. Only those persons who have signified their consent to serve, if elected, shall be nominated for or elected to such office.
